# Wisconsin Dartball 9-player World Series of Dartball Tournaments 

Series consists of 4 tournaments:
October 12, 2024 - Turner Hall, Watertown
January 11, 2025 - American Legion Post 53, Eau Claire
March 8, 2025 - Stadium View, Green Bay
State - April 5 \& 6, 2025 - Oshkosh
Deadline for entering the series is September 15, 2024
First 3 tournaments rules, total entry fee of $\$ 200$
(state is still a separate tournament and entry, but finish counts toward series points) Limited to 16 teams, $\$ 200$ paid guarantees entry in the first 3 tournaments.
Individual tournament entry fee of \$75 if not participating in the series, based on availability. No roster required, but once you shoot with a team, you cannot switch to another
Tournaments are Saturday only, format:
Teams will draw to be divided into 4 pools of 4 teams, once you draw for the first tournament, this will place your team for all 3 tournaments, so you will have different pool play opponents in each tournament.
One 9 inning game vs each team in your pool, 9:30, 10:30, and 11:30am start times. Each team must bat all 9 innings. Games can end in a tie. Coin flip determines home team.
All 4 places will play vs same place finishers from each pool. (1 vs 1's, 2 vs 2's, 3's vs 3's etc.). Head to head play will be the first tie breaker, then runs scored.
then most runs given up, then coin flip.
After pool play there will be a 2 out of 3 game, standard bracket of 4 teams each.
$1^{\text {st }}$ place bracket plays for $1^{\text {st }}$ thru $4^{\text {th }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ bracket plays for $5^{\text {th }}$ thru $8^{\text {th }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ bracket plays for $9^{\text {th }}$ thru $12^{\text {th }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ bracket plays for $13^{\text {th }}$ thru $16^{\text {th }}$
All teams will play in every round all day.
Bracket games start at 1:30pm and 3:30ish, should all be done by 6 pm.
Series scoring:
1 point for each win, every game played
$1^{\text {st }}$ place gets 15 bonus points, $2^{\text {nd }}-14$ points, $3^{\text {rd }}-13$ points, etc.
Points accumulate from each tournament, creating an overall power ranking.
State tournament is still entered separately and played normally, with series points scoring of 1 point for each win, and bonus points of: $1^{\text {st }}$ place: 20 points, $2^{\text {nd }}$ or $1^{\text {st }}$ consolation- 18 points, $3^{\text {rd }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }}$ consolation- 16 points, $4^{\text {th }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ consolation-14 points, $4^{\text {th }}$ consolation- 12 points.
Series prizes: $1^{\text {st }}$ place in an individual tournament: $\$ 100$ and team plaque (3 awarded)
Series final point standings awards: (based on 16 teams paid)
$1^{\text {st }}$ place: $\$ 500$ and individual plaques (15) and the title of "World Series Champions"
$2^{\text {nd }}$ place: $\$ 450$ and individual plaques (15)
$3^{\text {rd }}$ place: $\$ 400,4^{\text {th }}$ place: $\$ 350,5^{\text {th }}: \$ 300,6^{\text {th }}: \$ 200,7^{\text {th }}: \$ 150,8^{\text {th }}: \$ 100$
Max points for entire series is 94 points. Tie breaker for series points is head to head, then overall record, then state finish, then runs scored.
A page will be created on the Wisconsin Dartball Website to track point totals and create the official Dartball team power rankings for Wisconsin.
